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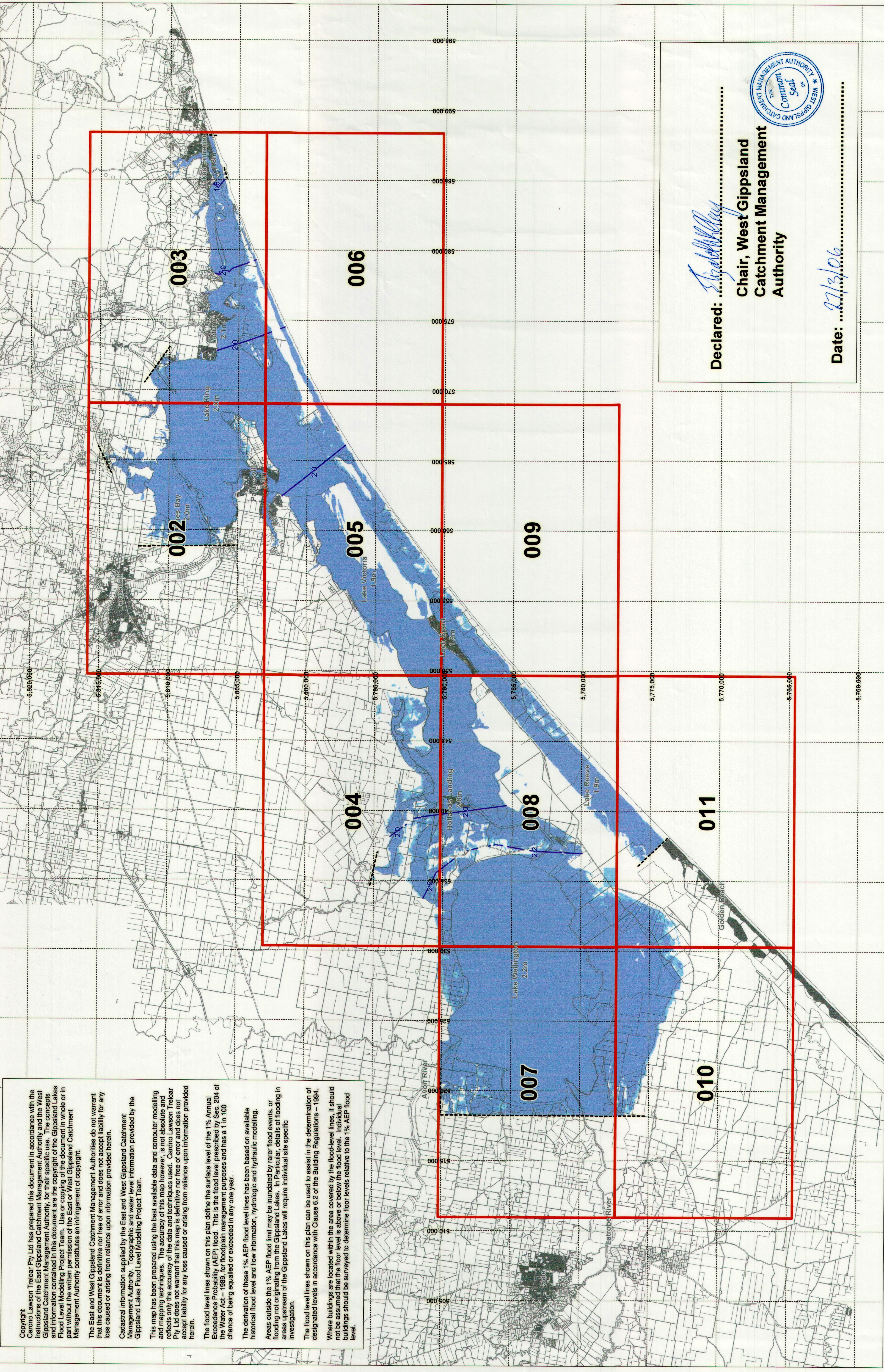

The flood level lines shown on this plan define the surface level of the 1% Annual Exceedance Probability (AEP) flood. This is the flood level prescribed by Sec. 204 of the Water Act - 1989, for floodplain management purposes and has a 1 in 100 chance of being equalled or exceeded in any one year.

The derivation of these 1% AEP flood level lines has been based on available historical flood level and flow information, hydrologic and hydraulic modelling. Areas outside the 1% AEP flood limit may be inundated by rarer flood events, or flooding not originating from the Gippsland Lakes. In particular, flooding in areas upstream of the Gippsland Lakes will require individual site specific investigation.

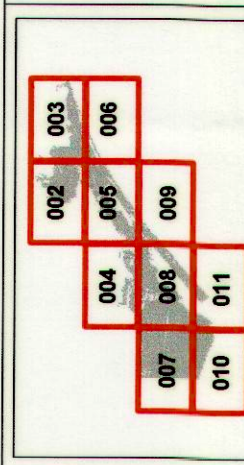
The flood level lines shown on this plan can be used to assist in the determination of designated levels in accordance with Clause 6.2 of the Building Regulations - 1994. Where buildings are located within the area covered by the flood-level lines, it should not be assumed that the floor level is above or below the flood level. Individual buildings should be surveyed to determine floor levels relative to the 1% AEP flood level.

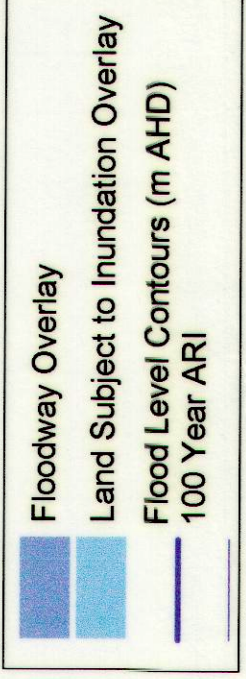
