**Description** This timber trestle bridge across the Latrobe River floodplain is situated at the 186.777 km mark (Exact location measured from designated start of route for roads and from Spencer Street 0km mark for railways) on Dandenong-Bairnsdale railway (115 m 23 c 38 l) east of Rosedale. Walk in 2.3 km from Rosedale-Longford Road.

The deck length is 81.0m, with a single track and a height of 4.0m. There are 18 main timber 4.5m spans. It has round piles, no stays, both slopes, half crossheads, no corbels, with square beams and a transverse deck with ballas
