Description This bungalow with its Federation detailing has an unusual feature in the entrance porch which is a quarter circle section with flat roof supported by Doric columns. A door is placed slightly asymmetrically within the curved wall. The garden has a curved path and lawn with plantings very similar to 155 Lansdowne Street. The woven wire fence with wrought iron gate set at the corner is sympathetic.

The house appears to be mostly intact to its early design although it is difficult to date the alterations to the central semicircular entry from a visual assessment. The building probably originally faced Turnbull Street as the larger projecting gable faces this street.
