Description An elegant originally symmetrical Victorian villa with an Edwardian addition to the rear. The verandah with its turned timber posts, returns to one side of the building and appears to date from the time of construction of the rear addition, probably early this century. There are two brick chimneys.

The house is in good condition with minor alterations, mostly executed at an early date, demonstrating Edwardian stylistic influences. Since 1994 a new fence has been erected and lacework has been added to the verandah that may be aluminium.

History This house was built in 1889.(1) The original allotment comprised two allotments with 33 foot frontages, now combined into the one block. The Cullen family, early owners, were butchers for many years. Later the property passed to the Ward family prior to the purchase by the Burrell family (2).

Bill Mason, who lives next door to this house, was born in what is now the doctor's surgery and is said to know about this house and locality.
