**Description** The Sale Milk Supply building is a Victorian shop with later (1940s?) shopfront (windows and doorway). It retains a Victorian parapet with simple mouldings (some may have been removed). It is now one of the few nineteenth or early twentieth century shops remaining on York Street.

The building retains its late nineteenth century form with the addition of a new shop front possibly reflecting the change from a hay and grain store to a dairy.

3.2 Dairying

**History** The building is said to date from the early 1890s having served as a hay and grain store for many years. The proprietor may have been L. L. Trimball. (1)

It has been a dairy for around 50 years, with Mr Jack Wilson having operated the dairy for 41 years. He recalls that there were around three or four dairies operating in Sale at any one time, with other examples being Adamson in York Street, Hawthorn Dairy in Raymond Street (also listed in this Study), and the Heyfield Dairy in Raglan Street.(1)

**Statement of significance** The former Sale Milk Supply at 178 York Street is of local historic significance to Wellington Shire. One of two remaining dairies in Sale, and one of three nineteenth century shops remaining in York Street, this shop is an important example of commercial activities relating to a nineteenth century town, and its changing functions illustrate the reducing use of horses for transport and the growth of the dairy industry within the region. (RNE criteria A.4, B.2 & D.2)
