**History** Currently owned by Sandilands.

First land owner. Ellen Gebbett, 11 / 10/ 1859.

The carrier, William Gebbet and his wife Ellen, owned a house on this allotment in 1863 (1). William was listed in Butler's 1866 Directory in Gibson Street (sic) (2) but not in the Post Office Directory of 1868 (3). By early this century, the house and lots 1, 4-8/2 belonged to George Frederick Belcher Langhorne; gentleman (4).

A photograph of the house, from the Langhorne Collection, shows its condition early this century, to be basically similar to the present. The house has a double gable roof form, is clad with weatherboards and the verandah roof a continuation of the main roof slope. Timber verandah posts support a simple frieze which curves to each capital. An unusual aspect of the house is the double, six-pane casement windows at either side of the doorway; the door itself having been replaced. A post is missing from the north verandah end and part of the frieze is gone. A tall (0400) arrow-head picket fence and wicket gate once existed at the front, whilst of the two Cordylines, one remains. The house is not as well maintained as other examples in Palmerston (25), (29), but it dates from the town's commencement (Butler 1982:47).
