History First land owner: George Scutt, 23/2/1858.

Tarraville butcher, George Scuff, owned both allotments eight and ten of this block in 1858 having purchased them for 52 pounds and 73 pounds respectively (1). By 1887, one Thomas L. Myers had purchased them (2). It appears that three years later, Constable J. O'Connor had acquired the adjoining block to the south (4). Henrietta O'Connor was the owner by 1918 (5).

Cast-iron friezes and brackets on stop-chambered posts comprise the decorative aspects of the house, whilst alterations include the replacement of the front fence, the colour scheme, and alterations to the openings. The house has the characteristic high hip roof of the earlier history of the Port, whilst the cast-iron decoration, which is evocative of its construction date, is not repeated elsewhere in Port Albert or Palmerston (Butler 1982:48).
