**PUBLIC AUTHORITY MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT
FLORA AND FAUNA GUARANTEE ACT (1988)**

This Agreement is made the22nd.....day of.....MARCH.....2004.

BETWEEN The Secretary to the Department of Sustainability and Environment, a body corporate established under the Conservation, Forests and Lands Act 1987, situated at Nicholson St, East Melbourne, Victoria.
(*The Secretary*)

AND The Chief Executive Officer of the Wellington Shire Council, being a delegated officer pursuant to Local Law No.6 of the Council in accordance with the Local Government Act, 1989, situated at the Civic Centre, Port of Sale, 70 Foster Street, Sale, Victoria
(*Wellington Shire Council*).

WHEREAS:

A. Section 25 of the *Flora and Fauna Guarantee Act* 1988 provides that -

- “(1) The Secretary may enter into an agreement with one or more public authorities to provide for the management of any taxon or ecological community or potentially threatening process.
- (2) The Secretary must cause notice of the making of the agreement to be published in the Government Gazette and the agreement must not come into force before notice is published.
- (3) The agreement must set out its purposes and aims, the duties and areas of responsibility of the parties and the date on which it begins and (if necessary) ends.
- (4) An agreement may be changed or terminated by mutual agreement between the parties according to the terms of the agreement.”

B. The taxon/a and ecological community/ies listed in Schedule C are found at the West Sale Aerodrome Complex.

C. The parties to this Agreement wish to enter into this agreement for the management of the taxon or ecological community in Schedule B, under Section 25 of the *Flora and Fauna Guarantee Act* 1988, in the following terms.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:

Interpretation

1. Unless inconsistent with the context or subject matter -
- 1.1 a reference importing the singular includes the plural and vice versa; and

-
- 1.2 headings and marginal notes are included for ease of reference and shall not alter the interpretation hereof; and
 - 1.3 references to an Act of Parliament or a section or schedule of it shall be read as if the words "or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof or substitution therefor" were added to the reference; and
 - 1.4 references to clauses, sub-clauses and paragraphs are references to clauses, sub-clauses and paragraphs of this agreement respectively; and
 - 1.5 each word or phrase defined in Schedule A shall elsewhere in this agreement have the meaning given to it in Schedule A.

Purposes and Aims of this Agreement.

2. The purposes and aims of this agreement are –
 - 2.1 to provide for the conservation of the taxon or ecological community listed in Schedule C to this Agreement at the site/s listed in Schedule B in accordance with the management practices described in Schedule C.

Undertakings of the Public Authority

3. The Public Authority **Hereby Undertakes:-**
 - 3.1 to manage the areas of the site/s described in Schedule B containing the taxon or ecological community described in Schedule C in accordance with the management practices outlined in Schedule C;

Undertakings of the Secretary

4. The Secretary **Hereby Undertakes:-**
 - 4.1 to provide advice to the Public Authority on the management of the taxon or ecological community listed in Schedule C.

General

5. The parties **Hereby Agree:-**
 - 5.1 that at any time they may by mutual agreement alter or vary this agreement by a like agreement; and
 - 5.2 that either party may terminate this agreement by giving 12 months written notice from the Secretary, or the delegate of the Secretary or the Authorised Officer of the Public Authority;
 - 5.3 that each party will notify the successor to that party of the existence of this agreement which binds such successors as if they had respectively been parties to this agreement;

- 5.4 that should a dispute arise under this agreement between the parties, the Secretary, or the delegate of the Secretary and the Authorised Officer of the Public Authority, acting reasonably, will use their best endeavours to resolve the dispute;
- 5.5 to maintain confidentiality as to the conservational significance of the site;
- 5.6 that an updated copy of Schedule D, the list of prohibited plant species, will be provided from time to time;
- 5.7 that this agreement comes into force on the date entered on page 1 of this Agreement or on the date that notice of making of the agreement is published in the Government Gazette, whichever is later.

SCHEDULES TO THIS AGREEMENT

SCHEDULE A

"**Act**" means the *Flora and Fauna Guarantee Act 1988*;

"**Agreement**" means this agreement and includes the schedules;

"**Department**" means the Department of Sustainability and Environment;

"**community**" or "**ecological community**" means a community of flora or fauna;

"**listed**" means that an item has been listed under the FFG Act as "Taxa or Communities of Flora and Fauna which are Threatened".

"**management practices**" means the management practices described as such in Schedule C;

"**nationally threatened**" species and communities are those listed and protected under the Federal *Environmental Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999*.

"**person**" includes a body corporate as well as an individual;

"**Public Authority**" means the party named and described as such on the page of this agreement and its successors in title the registered proprietor or registered proprietors for the time being of the land or any part of it;

"**schedules**" means schedules A to E (inclusive) to this agreement and "schedule" means any one of the schedules;

"**Secretary**" means The Secretary to the Department of Sustainability and Environment, a body corporate established under Section 6 of the *Conservation, Forests and Lands Act 1987*;

"**significant native vegetation**" means plants native to Victoria that are regarded by DSE as being of National, State or Regional Significance.

"**site**" means the area described as such in Schedule B;

"**special condition**" means a clause described as such in Schedule C and has the same force and effect as a clause in this agreement;

"**superintendent**" means a supervisor of works, technical operations manager, or any person responsible for works contracts, or any person nominated in a works contract.

"**taxon**" has the same meaning as ascribed to it in the Act, namely a taxonomic group of any rank into which organisms are categorised;

"**vegetation**" means any plant material, including trees, shrubs, grasses and herbs.

"**vehicle**" means motorbikes, cars, vans, four-wheel drive vehicles, farm machinery or earth-moving machinery

"**weed**" means any plant growing in the wrong place and competing with other plants for water, nutrients and light. Categories of weeds and responsibilities for their control are stated in the *Catchment and Land Protection Act 1994*, and the DSE website.

"**writing**" includes typing, printing, photography, lithography and other modes of representing or reproducing words in a visible form and "written" has a corresponding meaning.

"**DSE**" is an acronym for the Department of Sustainability and Environment.

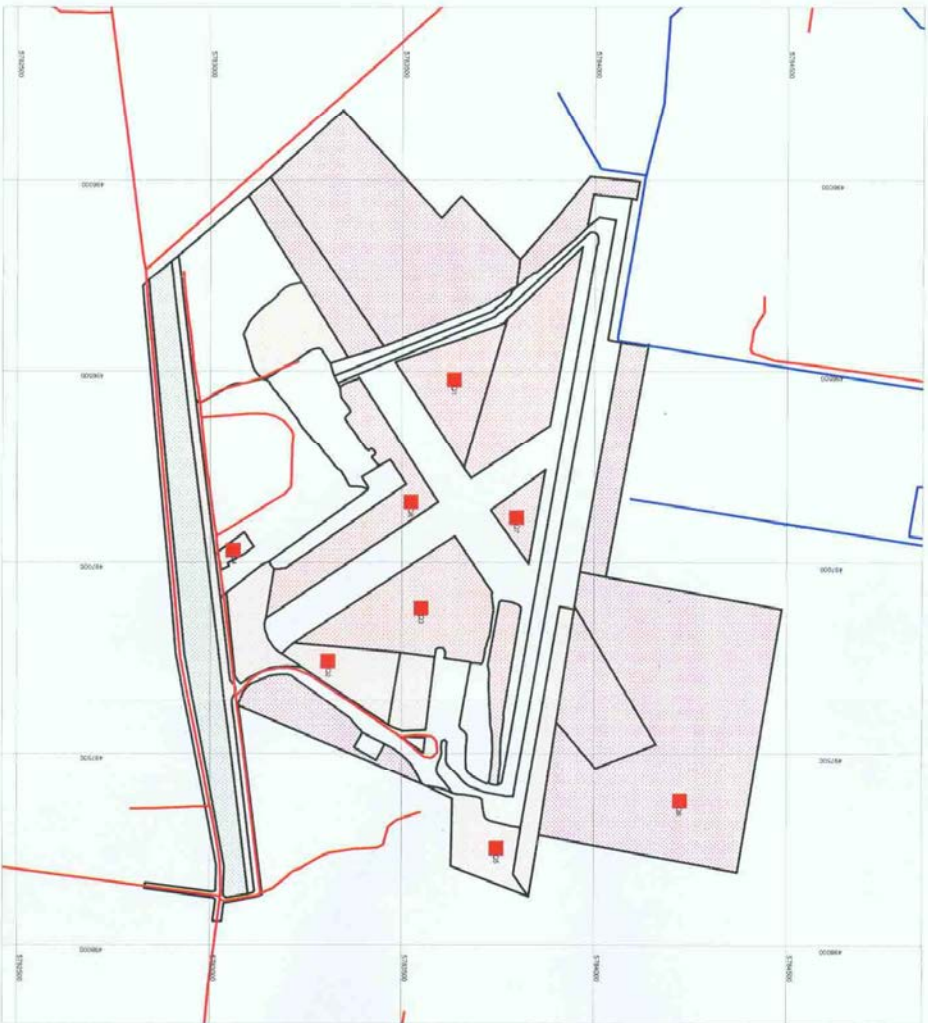

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SCHEDULE C

Taxon or Ecological Community

Central Gippsland Plains Grassland Community – listed as threatened under the FFG Act, 1988, including the following species:

Eragrostis trachycarpa (Rough grained lovegrass) – with a conservation status of rare in Victoria.

Management Practices

1. General

Management practices will aim to -

- 1.1 maintain the ecological processes that sustain the taxon and ecological communities located at the site/s listed in Schedule B; and
- 1.2 not plant or grow, or allow to continue growing or knowingly permit the planting or growth of the environmental weeds listed in Schedule D on the areas of the site containing the taxon or ecological community of flora and fauna; and
- 1.3 control and where possible eliminate the introduced plant species described in Schedule D from the area to be managed under this agreement without prejudice to conservation objectives; and
- 1.4 control and where possible eliminate introduced pest animals that may threaten the taxon or ecological community described above; and
- 1.5 undertake fire protection measures without prejudice to conservation objectives and to allow ecological burns where they do not compromise safety and fire protection requirements; and
- 1.6 maintain or increase where appropriate the amount of native vegetation present; and
- 1.7 where required, allow the Department of Natural Resources and Environment to provide expertise for the management of the species described above and the habitat it requires; and
- 1.8 in recognition of the site as a working aerodrome permit access to the site only by arrangement with Wellington Shire Council and the Aerodrome Manager; and
- 1.9 allow for collection of plant material and/or seeds for propagation purposes, on provision of written permission from the regional Flora and Fauna Manager, DSE; and
- 1.10 permit the Secretary or any authorised officer of the Department access to the site and the right to harvest, take away and remove the taxon or community of flora and fauna or any part or member of the taxon or community of flora and fauna including the seeds or roots thereof; and
- 1.11 allow for additional management aims or aims relating to the role of the Wellington Shire Council to be added.

2. Management Zones

- 2.1 that the site will be managed in accordance with the management zones allocated as per Schedule B Map 2.

3. Management Zone Guidelines

to decrease the level of threatening processes impacting on the grassland zones, specific management practices need to take place in each of the management zones outlined in Schedule B Map 2 as follows:-

3.1 TAFE Training Facility - Zone 1

- 3.1.1 a 20m buffer will be established on this land outside of, but adjacent to the grassland zones.
- 3.1.2 where practical any vegetation in this buffer will be slashed and kept to a minimum height of 100mm for the period between November to April.
- 3.1.3 no fertilizer is to be applied to the 20m buffer or to the adjacent Aerodrome Complex Zones (Zones 3-5).
- 3.1.4 weeds will be annually controlled within the 20m buffer and elsewhere in the zone, to ensure that they do not invade the adjoining Aerodrome Complex Zones (Zones 3-5).
- 3.1.5 the TAFE site manager will be encouraged to use species of the Central Gippsland Plains Grassland Community plants in future landscape designs (Schedule E).
- 3.1.6 where practical drainage will be contained within the zone.
- 3.1.7 Natural Resource Management students and staff will be encouraged to utilise the area as part of the vegetation management curriculum.
- 3.1.8 Natural Resource Management students and staff will be encouraged to carry out the grassland monitoring program developed by Wellington Shire Council as part of this Agreement. Data collected will be made available to Wellington Shire Council and DSE.

3.2 CFA Training Facility - Zone 2

- 3.2.1 a 20m buffer will be established on this land outside of, but adjacent to the grassland zones.
- 3.2.2 where practical any vegetation in the buffer zone will be slashed and kept to a minimum height of 100mm for the period between November to April.
- 3.2.3 no fertilizer is to be applied to the 20m buffer or to the adjacent Aerodrome Complex Zones (Zones 3-5).
- 3.2.4 weeds will be annually controlled within the 20m buffer and elsewhere in the zone, to ensure that they do not invade the adjoining Aerodrome Complex Zones (Zones 3-5).
- 3.2.5 the CFA site manager will be encouraged to use species of the Central Gippsland Plains Grassland Community plants in future landscape designs (Schedule E).
- 3.2.6 where practical drainage will be contained within the zone.
- 3.2.7 CFA staff will be encouraged to incorporate the management of the grassland in the fire training curriculum.
- 3.2.8 CFA students and staff will be encouraged to assist in the planning of the fire management plan for the site this should be done in consultation with staff from Wellington Shire Council and the Flora and Fauna Unit of DSE.

3.3 Aerodrome Complex (Existing and Future Development) - Zone 3, 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D & 6

- 3.3.1 weeds will be controlled annually particularly in the vicinity of all access tracks, drainage lines, bare areas of soil disturbance, and around buildings to ensure they do not invade the adjoining grassland.
- 3.3.2 grassed strip areas will be annually sprayed with a broadleaf selective herbicide in early Spring. Follow up spray will be applied over Summer should climatic conditions encourage broadleaf weed dominance. Methods to avoid spray drift will be employed.
- 3.3.6 Lessees will be encouraged to landscape their building surrounds using plants indigenous to Central Gippsland Plains Grassland (Schedule E).

3.4 Aerodrome Complex, Grasslands Zones - 4A, 4B, 4C, 4D

Program of Works

3.4.1 A five year works program for grassland management incorporating annual targets will be developed for on-ground works. This will be developed in consultation between the Wellington Shire Council and DSE and be reviewed by both parties at the conclusion of each five year period. Implementation of this works program will begin within its first year.

Ecological and Fuel Reduction Burning

3.4.2 burning will be used as a management tool where it is considered appropriate for the maintenance and enhancement of the native grassland community described above, the reduction of fuel or for the control or elimination of introduced species listed in Schedule D.

3.4.3 burns will be scheduled as part of the on-ground works program described in 3.5.1.

3.4.4 where practical, burns will be conducted using a mosaic pattern, one of the four grassland zones will be burnt in Autumn each year in accordance with CFA and Civil Aviation requirements. This will ensure that each block is burnt every four years.

3.4.5 burns will be conducted in accordance with NRE burn plans and guidelines which are specific to the rare flora and fauna present at the site.

3.4.6 mechanical fuel reduction involving discing and scalping will not be permitted in areas supporting the native grassland community.

Slashing

3.4.7 grassland zones that are not scheduled for burning may be cut and baled. The timing of this process should be monitored. Ideally cutting and baling should take place after the Kangaroo grass (*Themeda triandra*) has set seed, usually mid Summer. If bales are required for *Themeda triandra* re-establishment, cutting may take place earlier prior to the dropping of seed. All bales should be removed from the grassland zone.

Firebreaks

3.4.8 slashing may be used to prepare firebreaks provided the use of machinery does not result in soil disturbance such as cutting, compaction or rutting. Slashing for firebreaks should comply with 3.4.7. Any slash not required for baling should be collected or burnt.

Weed Control

3.4.9 a five year works program for weed control with annual targets will be included as part of 3.4.1.

3.4.10 weed control using herbicide will be carried out on foot in all grassland zones using a knapsack. The knapsack wand will have a cone attached to encourage accurate targeting of the herbicide and to reduce drift.

3.4.11 use of herbicides for weed control will be consistent with the minimum use required for infestation control. Herbicides will be chosen for their selectivity and will be the most environmentally safe available.

Vermin Control

3.4.12 a five year works program for vermin control with annual targets will be included as part of 3.4.1. Vermin control programs need to be sensitive to the rare flora present at the site.

Grazing

3.4.13 no grazing of domestic stock is allowed in the grassland zones (Zones 4A-4D).

Vehicles and Access

3.4.14 vehicular access to the grassland zone will be for aerodrome management purposes only and will be kept to a minimum with care taken not to disturb the vegetation and soil.

3.4.15 management work that requires access for machinery and vehicles when the soil is wet, should be deferred where practical, until the area has dried out.

3.4.16 no new roads or tracks should be constructed within the grassland zones without consultation between the Wellington Shire Council and DSE. Maintenance of existing tracks should be carried out so as to impact as little as possible on the native grassland areas.

Fencing

3.4.17 boundary fencing should be inspected annually and after all severe weather events and maintenance programmed as part of the annual works program (as described in 3.4.1).

Drainage and Earthworks

3.4.18 DSE will be consulted regarding any proposed drainage or earthworks that may impact on the native grassland area.

Vegetation Restoration Works

3.4.19 DSE will provide expertise and advice where vegetation restoration works are required. Any restoration plantings need to utilise species indigenous to the site.

Emergency Access and Works

3.4.20 if access is required for emergency purposes, including emergency access to drains and communications lines, restrictions on the movement of personnel vehicles and material do not apply, although the site shall be restored by the Wellington Shire Council or responsible agency to the satisfaction of the Secretary within 3 months; and

3.4.21 where practical, a DSE officer should be on site to assist in minimising damage to native flora and/or fauna.

3.4.22 where any major works are planned (eg. road construction, installation of public utilities) that may impact on significant native vegetation, the Wellington Shire must notify the local DSE Flora & Fauna Manager.

Training

3.4.23 the Wellington Shire Council is to arrange for attendance at suitable training courses for works crews and contractors.

Record Keeping

3.5.24 detailed records of all management carried out in the grassland zones will be maintained by the Aerodrome Manager. These records will include:

- details of burns, zone burnt, date burnt, extent of burn, intensity of burn etc.,
- weed control carried out, locations timing, herbicide rates, resultant impact etc.,
- details of any harvesting of grass seed, location, time, estimated yield
- any other works carried out in the blocks and its impacts on the land eg. facility maintenance etc.

Monitoring

- 3.4.25 Wellington Shire Council with assistance from DSE will develop a monitoring program for the site, and facilitate the implementation of this program by a local educational institution.
- 3.4.26 all Victorian Rare or Threatened plant species (VROTS) will be monitored and recorded by DSE on DSE's VROTPOP database;

Review

- 3.4.27 the management plan (Schedule C) should be reviewed by Wellington Shire Council and DSE, every five years;
- 3.4.28 any interested parties (eg. adjacent landholders, CFAs, Landcare groups) must be notified of any changes to the management plan, (Schedule C).

3.5 Grassland Re-establishment Area – Zone 5

- 3.5.1 Wellington Shire Council with assistance from DSE will develop a management plan specific for Zone 5, outlining a program for re-establishment of the grassland community within this 18.5ha site. This management plan should become part of Schedule C of this Agreement in the future.
