How we operate our dog breeding business;

- 1. Securing the dogs: we have pens with kennels to house the dogs at night or if they are on heat, in order to secure them (as shown on plan).
- 2. Exercising the dogs: during the day the dogs are free to run around the property in the fenced-off exercise yards (as shown on plan). We also walk the dogs on leads regularly at the Lake Guthridge and the rail trails.
- 3. Feeding of Dogs: The dogs are fed every morning at 7am with good quality dried food and processed sliced sausage meat (feeding once a day for adult dogs is recommended by our Vet). The dogs also get training treats during the day for training and raw bones once a week.
- 4. Disposal of waste products: All dog feces and other dog waste is scooped up every day and wrapped up and disposed of in waste bins which are picked up weekly by a private waste disposal service.
- 5. Cleaning: all dog sleeping areas and dog kennels are cleaned once a week using biodegradable cleaning products that are added to water to wash surfaces..
