From July 6, your red landfill bin collection is changing to fortnightly, which is fab for the planet but... maybe not so fab if you're knee-deep in nappies.



We get it. Babies are gorgeous little joy-bombs, but their dirty nappies? A totally different kind of bomb.

While you won't be able to dispose of nappies in your new FOGO bin, there are other options for residents who are producing more nappies than their red landfill bin can handle.

From 1 July 2026, your household will have the essential trio: a FOGO bin, recycling bin and landfill bin – the non-negotiables. You'll also have the option to request extra bins in whatever combination works for you (hello, flexibility), with the following annual costs:

- 120-litre general rubbish bin \$192 per year\* (or about \$3.70 per week)
- 240-litre recycling bin \$61 per year\* (or about \$1.17 per week)
- 240-litre FOGO bin \$83 per year\* (or about \$1.60 per week)

\*The above costs per additional bin are proposed for 2026/2027, and are subject to Council's standard budget processes. Any additional bin charges will be added to your property's rates notice. Renters will need to discuss their options with their landlord or estate agent.
